**NOTICE TO THE BAR AND PUBLIC REGARDING REQUESTS FOR SUBMISSION OF
GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FOR PRO SE DEBTORS**

Please be advised that the following identification requirements regarding requests for submission for pro se debtors are effective beginning February 7, 2011.

The Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey is implementing a policy requiring all individual and joint debtors who are not represented by an attorney (or "pro se"), to submit to the Court within 14 days of filing of the petition, a photocopy of an acceptable form of government issued photo identification.

Acceptable forms of photo identification include:

- State issued driver's license,
- U.S. Government issued passport, state issued photo ID card,
- Military photo ID card,
- Government employee photo ID card, or
- Other form of government issued photo identification.

The Court will issue requests for such governmental issued photo identification at the time of filing for all pro se petitions not accompanied by a photocopy of an acceptable form of photo identification. The information provided to the Court by the debtor will not become public information.
